


Dear Placer County Restaurant Owners and Managers,

Composting 101

All restaurants in Placer County have been given green composting bins which make composting as easy as 1-2-3!

- 1. Place pails in convenient spots throughout your kitchen.
- 2. Have your staff put all kitchen scraps and leftovers in the pails.
- 3. Empty the pails into the big green bins.
 Composting lessens the amount of methane, created and

The quickest way to reduce greenhouse gases, which is causing droughts, fires, and the rise in temperatures, is to reduce the amount of methane we create.
